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# VIKING CUP 2012



**SKÖVDE-SWEDEN**  
31st of March-1st of April

## Place and time of event

Viking Cup International 2012 will take place on the 31<sup>st</sup> of March and 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2012 in Skövde, Sweden.

The sports hall of the competition will be ARENA SKÖVDE located on Egnellsvägen 1, Skövde.

The competition will start: Saturday the 31<sup>st</sup> of March at 08.30.

The end of the competition is planned to: Sunday the 1<sup>st</sup> of April at approximately 20.00.

The exact schedule of the competition will be published after the deadline for sending the entry forms.

## Divisions and classes

The competitors will be divided into the following divisions and groups:

### ADULT (sparring and pattern)

### Attention!

Age for the competitors is based on the date of birth, not the year.

For example, you become a senior the day you turn 18 years old.

## Sparring

Weight classes for the sparring competition (Seniors and Juniors only) will be as follows:

### SENIORS

Female: -52 kg, -58 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg

Male: -54 kg, -63 kg, -71 kg, -80 kg, +80 kg

### JUNIORS

Female: -45 kg, -50 kg, -55 kg, -60kg, +60 kg

Male: -52 kg, -58 kg, -63kg, -70 kg, +70 kg

We reserve the right to mix classes if the number of competitors in a weight class is less than three persons.

## Pattern

In each division the competitors will perform one designated pattern chosen by the judges according to the participant with the lowest grade. In the semifinals and finals the competitors will perform two patterns, optional and designated. If possible, depending on the number of participants, there will be two patterns through out the whole competition. The pattern range in each division will be as follows:

### ADULT

#### SENIORS (18 years and above)

Top Level group A (3 Dan - 6 Dan)

from Chon Ji to Moon Moo

Top Level group B (1 Dan - 2 Dan)

from Chon Ji to Juche

High Level (2 Kup - 1 Kup)

from Chon Ji to Choong Moo

Medium Level (5 Kup - 3 Kup)

from Chon Ji to Toi Gye

#### JUNIORS (15-17 years)

Top Level (1 Dan - 3 Dan)

from Chon Ji to Choi Yong

High Level (2 Kup - 1 Kup)

from Chon Ji to Choong Moo

Medium Level (5 Kup - 3 Kup)

from Chon Ji to Toi Gye

### YOUTH

#### CADETS (12-14 years)

High Level (4 Kup - 1 Kup)

from Chon Ji to Choong Moo

Beginner Level (8 Kup - 5 Kup)

from Chon Ji to Yul Gok

#### MINIORS (8-11 years)

High Level (4 Kup - 1 Kup)

from Chon Ji to Choong Moo

Beginner Level (8 Kup - 5 Kup)

from Chon Ji to Yul Gok

Cadets and Miniors will compete in a mixed class boys and girls together.

## Entry fees

The entry fee is as follows:

SENIOR and JUNIOR: **50 EUR/person**

CADET and MINIOR: **25 EUR/person**

## Accommodation

### Hotel

The hotels are of high quality with a toilet, a shower and a TV in each room. The price includes accommodation and breakfast. The hotels are situated near the centre of the town.

The price for accommodation is:

Place in a double room: **60 EUR/person/night**

Place in a single room: **80 EUR/person/night**

Supporters who make reservation for accommodation by the organizing committee will have free entrance to the competition both Saturday and Sunday.

### **Booking**

All reservations of accommodation, and changes in the reservations, are made **ONLY** by the organizing committee. Please state the accommodation details in the Entry Form package (xls-document). Please note that the number of rooms is limited, so please make your reservation as soon as possible.

The Entry Form package should have reached the organizing committee at the latest the **9<sup>th</sup> of March 2012**.

### **Changes in the accommodation reservation**

It is possible to make **small changes** in the reservations until the **20<sup>th</sup> of March 2012**. After this date there will not be possible to change the reservations and the entry form will be used as the base of calculating the cost of accommodation that the club/organization should pay.

## **Entry and Payment requirements**

To enter the Viking Cup 2012 follow these steps:

### **STEP 1**

Fill in and send the "Entry Form" package to the Organizing Committee. After this the Organizing Committee will get in touch with the contact person for each organization/club to confirm the preliminary booking of accommodation.

Important! The Entry Form, should have reached the organizing committee at the latest the **9<sup>th</sup> of March 2012**. After this date we can not guarantee places in the hotels or the above mentioned prices.

### **STEP 2**

When the preliminary booking for accommodation has been confirmed every organization/club should pay 50% of the whole amount to the following account:

Please note that the reservation of accommodation will not be accepted until the requested amount has reached the organizers account. Deadline for payment is the **20<sup>th</sup> of March 2012**.

Conceivable fees for making the payment should be paid by the delegations and not by the organizer.

### **STEP 3**

After that the amount has reached the organizers account your booking will be officially accepted. This will be confirmed to the contact person for each organization/club.

### **STEP 4**

The remaining 50% of the amount for accommodation will be paid **ONLY IN EURO** and **CASH** at arrival during the teams registration. Attention! Credit cards or other payments than cash will not be accepted during registration.

Of course, it is also possible to make the whole payment to the bank account in advance.

## Swedish currency

N.B. The currency used in Sweden is Swedish Crowns SEK. EUROS are not accepted in stores or restaurants. Make sure that you have exchanged your currency before arriving to Skövde as there are limited possibilities to exchange money during the week-end.

## Participation conditions

To be able to take part in Viking Cup International 2012 the Entry Form package must have reached the organizing committee at the **latest the 9<sup>th</sup> of March 2012**.

The next condition for participating in Viking Cup International 2012 is that all fees, entry fee and accommodation fee, are paid according to the requirements stated above.

## Additional fee for changes

As there has been too many last minute changes in the entries the last years, which has caused problems for the organizing committee, the decision to introduce an additional fee for changes has been made.

Every change from one competition group to another (weight category or division) made on the arrival day, the 30<sup>rd</sup> of March, will result in an additional fee of **20 EURO/change**.

This additional fee should be paid during registration or weigh-in.

## Insurance

All competitors must have full insurance coverage for eventualities by their own club. The Organizer will not be financial responsible for possible injuries caused during the competition.

## Registration and Weigh-In

The registration and weigh-in will take place on **Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> of March between 12.00-20.00** in Hotel PRISMA, Ekedalsgatan 2, Skövde.

All competitors must during the weigh-in show their passport or other identification document.

## Rules

The rules for the competition will be the official rules of the International Taekwon-Do Federation with adaption according to the Swedish regulations.

## Equipment regulations

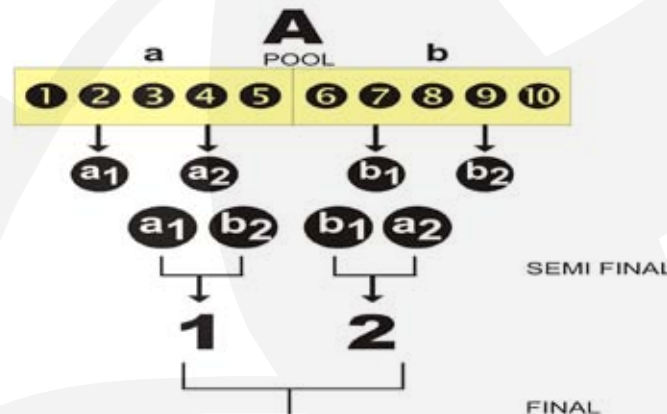
According to ITF regulations all competitors **must wear head protection** during the sparring event. All participants should be in possession of their own protection gear.

## System of competition

The competition in sparring will be performed in a pool-system which means that all participants will be divided into pools up to five persons where everybody fights everybody. The competitors with the highest score will advance to the next pool.

In pattern the competition will be according to a traditional pyramid system.

## Umpires

The organizer will pay accommodation for 2 umpires with black belt from each club/organization who will be present and take part in the whole competition.

Lunch will be served to the umpires during the competition.

Information about time and location for the umpire meeting will be given during registration.

## Coaches

All coaches must wear training suite and indoor shoes during the competition.

The **coach meeting** will take place on Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> of March. Information about time and location will be given during registration.

## Prizes

Each competitor will be competing for his/her Taekwon-Do school and country.

- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and two 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each category and division will receive the official Viking Cup International medal.
- The best club of the competition according to total medal statistic in all divisions together will receive the main prize: the Viking Cup. A 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize will also be awarded.
- All competitors, coaches and umpires will receive a Participation Certificate.
- All Cadets and Miniors, independent of their result, will receive a Viking Cup souvenir.

## **How to get to Skövde**

You can get to Skövde in many different ways:

### **By air plane**

The best way is to first fly to Gothenburg and from there take the bus or train which travels directly to Skövde. The train ride takes approximately 1 hour.

### **Transfer**

We are also able to arrange transportation from the airport in Gothenburg to the hotel in Skövde. Please contact the organizing committee for details and prices concerning this.

### **By train**

Skövde has good connections by railway with most Swedish cities. However, the fastest connections are with Stockholm and Gothenburg where you can choose between X2000 train (express) or ordinary train.

### **By car**

There are no problems to travel comfortable by car in Sweden. Most of the roads are of very good standard, no matter how the weather conditions are.

## **Food**

There are many restaurants in Skövde so there will be no problem with finding a place for lunch or dinner. During the competition Restaurant Valle, which is located about 100 meters from the Arena, will be open for lunch. In the city centre, which is about 500 meters from the Arena, many restaurants are open during daytime and in the evenings.
