B. REGULATION

1. PARTICIPANTS

Sports structures with C.I.S. issued by the National Agency for Sport (former Ministry of Sport), affiliated to the Romanian Taekwon- do I.T.F. Federation and with the fees paid for the year 2024, as well as international clubs that have applied to participate in the event and will later be approved by the Federal Board strictly for this event.

Only athletes with the degrees granted by the Romanian Taekwon-do Federation I.T.F., unlimited number of athletes / category / club for clubs in Romania, respectively foreign athletes registered to clubs outside Romania, participate.

The grades (for Romanian athletes) will be paid into the federation's account until the date of registration in the competition and the athletes will be validated by the Members' Registration Commission. In order to avoid any doubts, we ask the presidents of the clubs to send the proof of payment and the identity documents for the athletes for whom it has not been previously sent, in order to be validated in the online system, to the secretary@taekwondo-itf.ro email address.

Minimum grade allowed: juniors III, II: 9 Gup - individual, 8 Gup - teams

3. ATHLETES' EQUIPMENT

- The official equipment is the one approved and approved by FRTKD ITF, A.E.T.F and I.T.F.
- Each athlete's equipment will be checked by a designated referee at their entrance to the competition surface.
- Athletes will have access to the competition surface only accompanied by an ITF Taekwon-do instructor or coach, based on the identification card, being equipped in the colour of the corner, 2 minutes before the start of the match, according to the competition grids.

4. PROTESTS

They are made on the basis of the competition rules. In case of appeal, the coach must present the money and fill in the appeal form on the spot, at the *Jury President* table of the respective ring, within a maximum of 5 minutes from the end of the meeting in question.

5. THE WEIGHT-IN

The weighing of the athletes will be done:

- Upon registration, at Everest Hotel, 16-18 Uzinei Street, Friday 05.12.2024, from 14:30 to 16:30, for all age and weight categories in combat events;
- At the Simon Ladislau Sports Hall, str. Alea Parcul Sportivilor nr. 1, Saturday, 06.12.2025, from 08:00 to 08:30;

At the weight-in, it is not allowed to exceed the maximum limit of the category!

The athletes will present themselves with their ID card, in dobok pants and a T-shirt on the scales, these totalling 0.5 kg that will be subtracted.

Athletes who exceed the weight limit on the scale have 1 hour (Friday evening only) to confirm the category. If at the second weight-in on Friday the athletes do not fall into the category in which they were registered, they will be withdrawn from the sparring event.

C. REGISTRATION

1. COMPOSITION OF DELEGATIONS

Each delegation can be made up of:

- 1 delegation leader.
- 1 or more accredited coaches and/or instructors for the year 2025.
- competitors – juniors III, II (male and female).
- 1 or more accredited referees for the year 2025.

Note: The leader of the delegation has the obligation to present the Accident Responsibility at the weight-in, a form signed in printed format (not by email), otherwise the club will not have the right to compete.

2. REGISTRATIONS IN THE SYSTEM AND CHANGES

The registration of athletes, referees, instructors in the competition will be done online until 25.11.2025, 23:59, each delegation leader receiving prior access based on username and password to the electronic registration system.

The address at which online registrations will be made is: <https://system.taekwondo-itf.ro> for Romanian competitors or https://www.sportdata.org/taekwondo_itf/set-online/ for foreign guests.

On 26.11.2025, 23:59, checks will take place and only the following types of changes can be made:

- Weight changes (moves from one category to another): free of charge.
- Other erroneous registration changes: free of charge.
- Any withdrawal of athletes during this period is free of charge.
- Any addition of athletes during this interval will result in the application of a late fee of 200 RON (40€), according to the decision of the Romanian Board.

After 26.11.2025, 23:59, no modification, addition or withdrawal is accepted, the clubs having the obligation to pay the participation for all the athletes they have registered in the competition.

Any inconsistency will be clarified with Mr. Cristian Popa – 5 Dan, Secretary and Chairperson of the Registration Committee.

3. PARTICIPATION FEES

- Athlete participation fee: 60 lei / category / athlete
- team participation fee: 30 lei / person / for each team to which the same athlete registers – juniors III, II, male, female
- Umpiring fee:
 - 200 lei (40 €) for each registered club.
 - Additional 350 lei (70€) for each missing umpire.

4. BILLING AND PAYMENTS

The invoices for the participation fees will be issued by Jaguar Academy Mureş Sports Association, and the clubs have the obligation to pay them only by bank transfer to its account until 28.11.2025. Foreign guests may pay cash at the registration upon arrival.

D. OTHER INFORMATION

1. REFEREES

Participating clubs are required to ensure at least:

- Clubs with 1 to 4 registered athletes are exempt from bringing umpires.
- Clubs with 5 to 10 registered athletes must bring at least 1 umpire.
- Clubs with 11 to 20 registered athletes must bring at least 2 umpires.
- Clubs with 21 or more registered athletes must bring at least 3 umpires.

The referees will be from those accredited by the federation for the 2025 competition year, except for foreign umpires.

The organizing club will pay the accommodation for the mandatory number of umpires registered as per the previous paragraph.

The accommodation of the referees will be made at Hotel Everest, Tg. Mureş strictly within the number of referees calculated according to the previous paragraph. The other referees will bear their accommodation and meal expenses.

Referees are required to attend the pre-announced online umpire meeting. Those who are not present at the online meeting will be excluded from the list of referees and will lose their rights.

The referees will have the regular attire of an I.T.F. referee. Those who do not have a regular attire will be excluded, losing their umpiring benefits (accommodation, payment). The accepted referees are those on the list of referees accredited and validated by the Romanian Taekwon-Do I.T.F. Federation, updated for 2025, as well as from the international guests' referees registered to the event.

The referees' behaviour, performance and remuneration will be analysed and decided by the members of the Umpire Committee and the Chairperson, Mr. Ciprian Banea – 5 dan.

Umpires who wish to work as referee (accredited for 2025) but do not fall under paragraph 3, will have the meal conditions similar with the other referees (excluding accommodation).

If the number of referees registered by the clubs is greater than the required number of referees, their selection will be made by the Chairperson of the Umpire Committee, and the list of selected referees will be communicated to the clubs by 26.11.2025.

2. INSTRUCTORS / COACHES

Instructors/coaches must be dressed in tracksuits, sports shoes and have a towel.

Only one person (coach / instructor) is allowed to accompany the athlete to the combat space. The coaches of the sports clubs will designate a second instructor to go with the athlete if two athletes from the same club participate simultaneously in the competition.

The instructors registered for the competition will have a legitimization ID and will not be able to assist the athlete in the chair without it.

3. REWARDS

Rewards for each weight and gender category, as follows:

- The athletes will be awarded with diplomas and medals for the I, II and III places according to the rules.
- Trophies will be awarded for the general classification at: junior III and junior II.

4. CONTROL DOPING

The Romanian Taekwon-do ITF Federation will ask coaches to come with athletes to doping control according to ANAD requests.

5. ACCOMMODATION

6. DISCIPLINE

The heads of delegations have the obligation to notify the athletes and their supporters about the maintenance of order in the competition hall, about the obligation of the supporters not to enter the competition area, about the obligation of the athletes to leave the space intended for the competition immediately after the end of the race.

Considering the analysis made at the previous events of the federation, the Federal Board decided to strictly apply the Organizational Regulations of the Commission for Combating Violence in Sport, which can be consulted on the page https://www.taekwondo-itf.ro/wp-content/uploads/2017/01/Regulamentul_de_organizare_si_functionare_a_Comisiei_de_Combatere_a_Violentei_in_Sport.pdf.

The organizing committee informs all participants that non-compliance with discipline and order in the competition space may lead to sanctions.

7. OTHER INFORMATION

At the award ceremony, it is mandatory for athletes to wear sports shoes and dobok / tracksuit (awards in other equipment are not accepted).

The competition schedule will be posted on the website and communicated to the clubs no later than 04.12.2024.
